- 3. This certificate is valid whilst the approved continuing airworthiness management organisation remains in compliance with Annex I (Part-M), Annex Vb (Part-ML) and Annex Vc (Part-CAMO) to Commission Regulation (EU) No 1321/2014.
- 4. Where the continuing airworthiness management organisation subcontracts under its management system the service of an (several) organisation(s), this certificate remains valid subject to such organisation(s) fulfilling applicable contractual obligations.
- Subject to compliance with the conditions 1 to 4 above, this certificate shall remain valid for an 5. unlimited duration unless the certificate has previously been surrendered, superseded, suspended or revoked.

If this form is also used for air operator certificate (AOC) holder (air carriers licensed in accordance with Regulation (EC) No 1008/2008), the AOC number shall be added to the reference, in addition to the standard number, and the condition 5 shall be replaced by the following additional conditions:

- 6. This certificate does not constitute an authorisation to operate the types of aircraft referred to in condition No 1. The authorisation to operate the aircraft is the AOC.
- Termination, suspension or revocation of the AOC of a air carrier licensed in accordance with 7. Regulation (EC) No 1008/2008 automatically invalidates the present certificate in relation to the aircraft registrations specified in the AOC, unless otherwise explicitly stated by the competent authority.
- Subject to compliance with the previous conditions, this certificate shall remain valid for an unlimited 8. duration unless the certificate has previously been surrendered, superseded, suspended or revoked.
